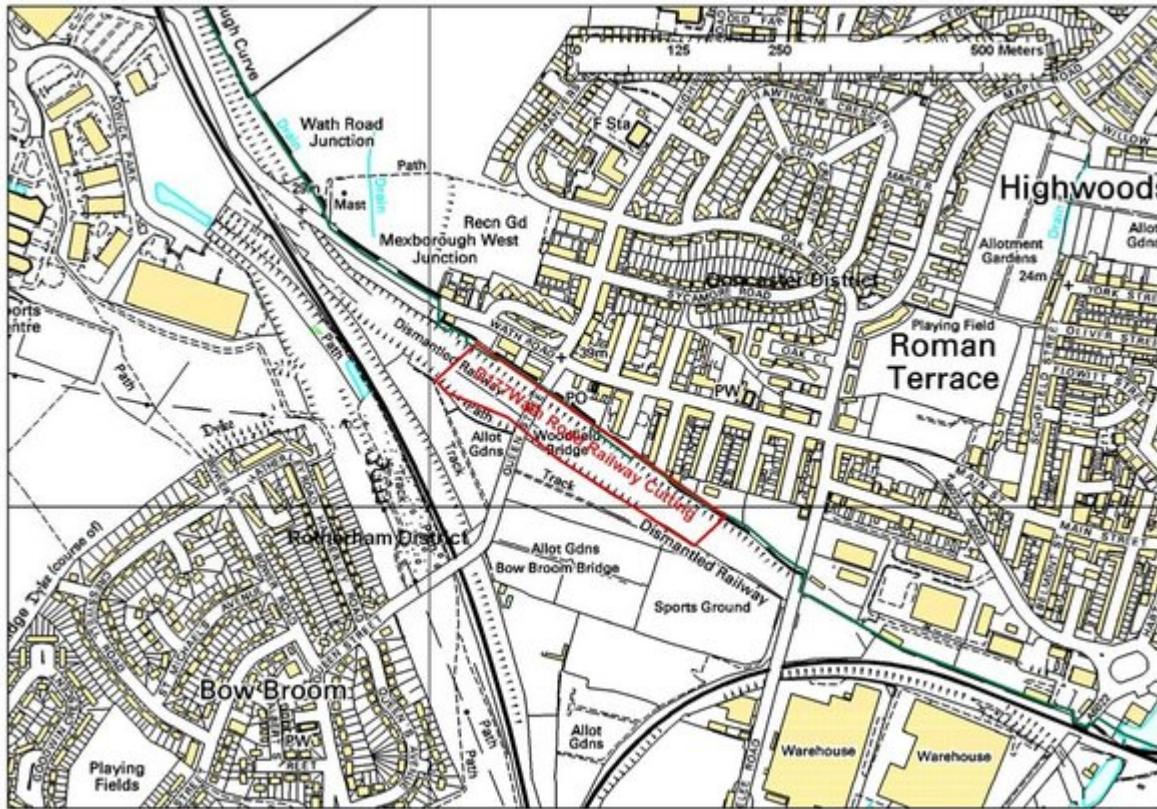
Former site of old railway cutting with good exposures of Mexborough Rock but now completely infilled. Most of former site is situated in Rotherham MBC.
