Locality: Strathspey in the vicinity of Chreagdhubh Lodge and the Woods of Glentruim, 5 km SW of Newtonmore.

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Type: Landform assemblage

Description: A suite of pristine glacial, fluvioglacial and alluvial features, including eskers, kettleholes and kame terraces.

Justification: This visually attractive suite of features is visible from the Cluny's Cave carpark, where an interpretive display board could be erected. The landforms were mainly formed at the snout of an outlet glacier, flowing from the west, that existed for a while during ice-sheet deglaciation.
